



#### Hong Kong Customs seizes suspected scheduled dried totoaba fish maws



Hong Kong Customs on 3 March seized about 1.2 kilograms of suspected scheduled dried totoaba fish maws with an estimated market value of about \$260,000 at Hong Kong International Airport.

Through risk assessment, Customs on that day inspected an air express parcel, declared to be carrying gifts and clothing, arriving in Hong Kong from Mexico. Upon inspection, Customs officers found the batch of suspected scheduled dried totoaba macdonaldi fish maws wrapped with clothes inside

the parcel. An investigation is ongoing.

#### **Taiwan POC**

#### Taiwanese convicted of rhino horn smuggling repatriated from Eswatini



Two Taiwanese serving jail terms in Eswatini after being convicted of attempting to smuggle rhino horns out of the Southern African country in 2017 were escorted back to Taiwan Thursday evening to serve the remainder of their sentence.

Initially serving an 11-year jail term and having already served five, the Taiwanese inmates were recently granted a commuted sentence, which ends at the end of this year, by the government of Eswatini, the bureau

said, adding that the men will now serve their remaining time in Taiwan.

The rhino horns that the two men tried to smuggle via their luggage out of Eswatini into Taiwan were valued at NT\$72 million (US\$2.53 million), the bureau said. According to an Agence de Presse Africaine report at the time, they were caught at the King Mswati III International Airport with 24 pieces of chopped up rhino horns from four killed animals on Feb. 25, 2017.
