Hong Kong Customs seizes over 1 tonne of suspected scheduled dried shark fins



On 7 January 2021, Hong Kong Customs seized over 1 tonne of suspected scheduled dried shark fins of endangered species with an estimated market value of about \$750,000 at Hong Kong International Airport.

Through risk assessment, Customs officers inspected an air consignment arriving in Hong Kong from the Philippines and found the batch of suspected scheduled shark fins inside.

The case was handed over to the Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department for follow-up investigation.

Three travellers jailed for smuggling dried shark fins and dried seahorses



Three travellers who smuggled dried shark fins and dried seahorses were convicted for violating the Protection of Endangered Species of Animals and Plants Ordinance, and were sentenced to imprisonment on 11 January 2021.

A spokesman for the Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department (AFCD) said that the three travellers arrived in Hong Kong on August 23, 2019, from Manila, the Philippines. About 48, 63 and 72 kilograms of dried fins from silky

sharks (Carcharhinus falciformis) were respectively found in the check-in baggage of these three travellers by Customs officers, as well as some 0.56kg of dried seahorses in one of the travellers' check-in baggage.

Subsequent to follow-up investigations, the AFCD charged the men with illegal import of listed species in Appendix II to the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES). They were convicted at the District Court earlier and each sentenced to 18 months' imprisonment on 11 January 2021.
