

Case Progress: The court sentenced defendant Gong to one year in prison, suspended for one year, and fined CNY 10,000 for the crime of harming endangered wild animals. In addition, because Gong used prohibited hunting tools during non-hunting season in the game reserve, resulting in destroying wildlife resources, harming the local ecological environment, and jeopardizing the public interest, the court ordered the defendant Gong to bear the cost of restoring the ecological environment damage of CNY 5,720 and the expert appraisal and assessment fee of CNY 3,000, and publicly apologized in the media at or above the municipal level within 60 days after the judgment took effect. After the verdict was pronounced, Gong pleaded guilty and accepted the verdict in court. No further appeal is made.
