They were sentenced to fixed-term imprisonment ranging from eight months to one year and six months, with probation periods ranging from one to two years, and fines ranging from RMB 4,000 to 5,000 (the fines have been paid).

- 2. In the incidental civil public interest litigation, the four defendants are jointly liable for ecological damages compensation of RMB 54,000 (which has been paid); among them, three defendants are jointly liable for ecological damages compensation of RMB 18,000 (which has been paid).
- 3. The four defendants in the incidental civil public interest litigation are ordered to publicly apologize via provincial-level or above media in Qinghai Province within ten days from the effective date of this judgment (this has been fulfilled).
- 4. The following tools used in the commission of the crime shall be confiscated: one bag of wire snares, one knife, one Wuling-brand van, and one motorcycle. The following confiscated items shall also be confiscated: two musk deer carcasses, four musk pods, two musk deer tails, and four animal fangs. Three musk deer carcasses and one animal antler unrelated to this case shall be transferred by the seizing authority, the Nangqen County Public Security Bureau of Yushu Tibetan Autonomous Prefecture, Qinghai Province, to the Nangqen County Natural Resources and Forestry and Grassland Bureau of Yushu Tibetan Autonomous Prefecture, Qinghai Province, for disposal according to law. Three mobile phones shall be returned in accordance with the law.
