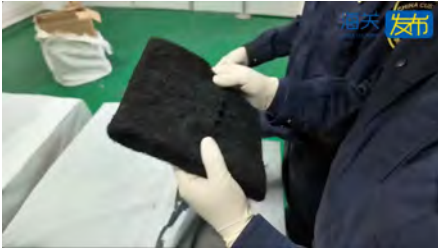

Six People Were Sentenced for Illegally Purchasing, Killing and Selling Protected Birds
